In regard to this review I would like to explain my situation.

I live 5Kms (as the crow flies) from Goulburn NSW, I cannot receive Internet except by satellite which costs \$60 per month for 2gb in peak time Where i work in Canberra we get 200gb for the same price. Telstra have told us we will never get ADSL!

I cannot receive free to air TV analog or digital unless I am willing to pay about \$3000.00 for aerials. We have to make do with satellite pay TV and relive the 60,70,80's TV. If the wind is in the right direction we can get 3g mobile phone but only in certain locations in the house.

I have sent emails over the past few years to Govt Dept's and even the last three Prime Ministers one replied to say they would enquire into the situation heard nothing since!

Perhaps with this review we will actually get some action.
