We wish to submit the attached photos as proof of lack of telecommunication services on our farm 15 Km east of Quairading.

Photo 1. Our telephone cable runs above the ground across the main gateway of our neighbours property. They have property both sides of this road so cable is constantly being run over with farm machinery, utes, road trains, harvesters, tractors etc.



Photo 2. Cable is laying across sprayed fire break. Why couldn't this cable be run between the trees and fence.
