Subject: Mobile Phone Reception Maryborough QLD

The mobile phone reception in areas of the Fraser Coast is non-existent.

Especially along the Maryborough/Hervey road, between Dundathu which is 2 kilometres outside of Maryborough and Kawungan which is at the entrance to Hervey Bay.

This is the major road linking the two cities and is the main commuter corridor for road transport, workers and tourists. It is constantly undergoing repairs, is prone to flooding and fog and unfortunately has a high vehicle accident rate.

In the 21st century and with a population of 65,000 it is not unrealistic to expect mobile phone reception along a major corridor.
